


The Children's Museum of Indianapolis is celebrating its 100th birthday and wants to help you celebrate yours too!

Here's what to do:

- 1** Mix the Starry with the cake mix. No other ingredients are needed!
- 2** Bake according to the instructions on the back of the box.
- 3** Allow cake to cool.
- 4** Add icing and candles.
- 5** Celebrate your special day!



How does a can of soda replace eggs, water, and oil?

Regular cake ingredients react with baking powder in the cake, creating carbon dioxide. The carbon dioxide bubbles in the soda help the cake rise to be nice and fluffy—and delicious!
