Instructions:

- Before your visit, print out the checklist and picture pages to help you plan your time at the museum.
- You can read about each gallery on our website and on our sensory map to decide where you want to go.
- Cut out the cards for each area you want to visit and attach them to your checklist. You may want to leave some spaces blank so you can add to your list during your visit.
- Bring your checklist with you to the museum. You may also want to bring the set of cards to say when you need to take a break, use the restroom, etc.
- If appropriate, please go over the "Museum Rules" below with your child prior to your visit.

Museum Rules:

- I will stay with my family, group, or caregiver when we are in the museum.
- I will use my indoor speaking voice.
- I will use my walking feet inside the museum.

General Museum Tips

- Parking is FREE in our garage or surface lots on Illinois Street.
- Youth under 16 must be accompanied by an adult at all times. The museum is weapon and smoke-free.
- Wi-Fi is available during museum hours.
- Wear play-ready shoes! Closed toe shoes are recommended for the Riley Sports Legends Experience® and are required for the Oval Track racing experience.
- Carousel rides are \$2; free for members! Accommodations can be made for visitors with disabilities who wish to ride our Carousel. It is accessible for visitors who use wheelchairs. Ask a staff member for assistance.
 - Please note: riding of Carousel animals is limited to children 17 and under only. Adults are still welcome to sit on the benches or stand beside their child at no cost but will no longer be permitted to ride on the animals.
- Centennial Ferris Wheel: Museum admission or membership required, plus an additional ticket purchase of \$6 for members or \$8 for nonmembers and Access Pass cardholders.
 - Please note: Riders must be at least 32" tall to ride with a supervising companion and at least 42" tall to ride alone.
- Lockers and stroller rentals are available in the Welcome Center.

General Museum Tips

- There are family restrooms throughout the museum, as well as a private nursing area in Playscape on Level 3. There is an adult-size, height-adjustable changing table in one of the Lower Level Dinosphere family restrooms.
- Most activities within the museum are included with museum admission. Each exhibit or program space displays a sign with activity times and other information.
- Fidget items and noise-reducing headphones are available at the Concierge Desk. Our concierge or a member of our security staff can also help you find a quiet space if needed. A Take a Break Space is located on Level 3.
- Sensory maps are available on the accessibility page of our website and at the Box Office, Entry Gates, and Concierge Desk on Level 1.
- Each exhibit has a sensory information sign posted at their entry spaces. Visitors may use these to predict what types of environments or opportunities the exhibit presents, and how best to prepare. Each sign has a QR code to scan for more information about the exhibit/sensory map. This information can also be located on the museum's website and exhibit page.
