Length: ~7.5 meters (~24.6 feet)

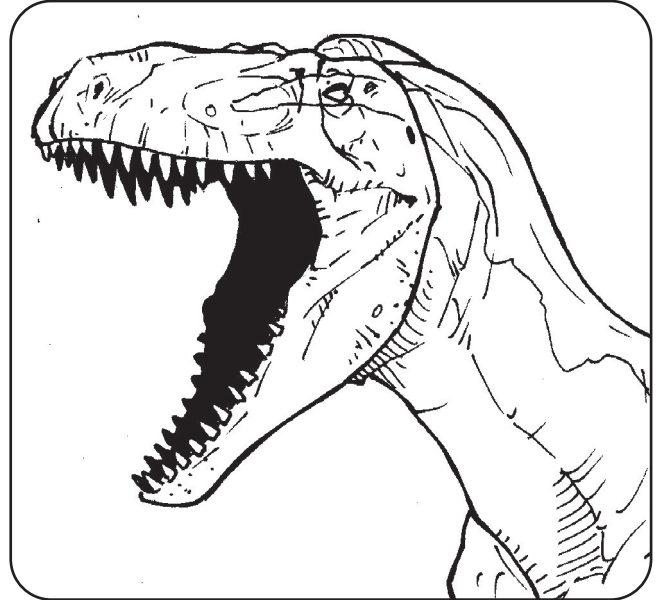
Mass: .45-.91 tonnes (1000-2000 pounds)
