

Fun Facts: The *Rajasaurus* lived in a river valley in what is now known as India 67 million years ago. Its name was inspired by the Sanskrit word *raja*, meaning king, for the "crown" of small horns on the skull.

The single *Rajasaurus* discovered was well-preserved by igneous rock formed when lava cooled around it. What does this tell you about what happened in the area after this specimen died?
