Mass: 2.4 tonnes (5,291 pounds)

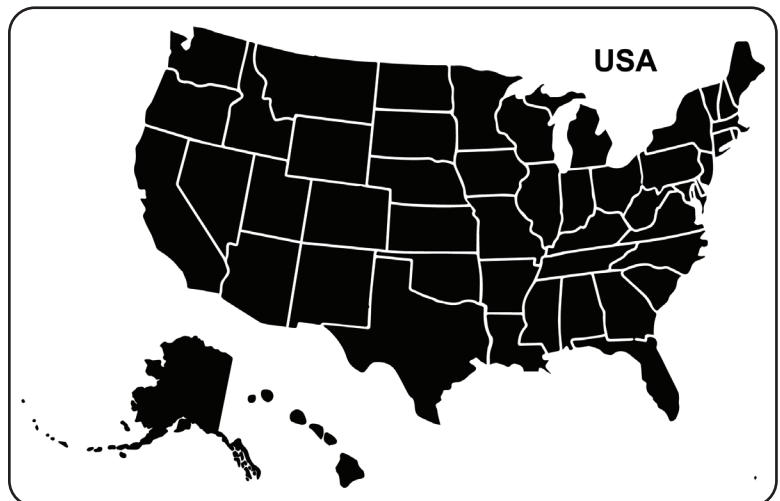
Diet: Herbivore

Fun Facts: The Zuul was covered in thick bony armor, with a long semi-ridged tail of spikes running along both sides, ending in a club that would have damaged the legs of even the largest theropods.
